Hall of Fame Scholarship

Formed in 2012, the PHAALS Foundation serves patients and families stricken with ALS (Lou Gehrig's Disease). PHAALS provides services to the ALS community, helps promotes ALS awareness, raises funding for Foundation services and provides families with the Diamond Dreams Program. The PHAALS Foundation also provides the PHAALS Hall of Fame Scholarship to approved families with ALS. PHAALS is a not-for-profit Foundation (501(c)3, TIN 46-1448861) whose mission is to help in the fight for a cure for Lou Gehrig's Disease and enrich the lives of families battling ALS.

Scholarship

Minimum of \$2,500 of non-renewable scholarships will be awarded each year.

Qualifications

The Hall of Fame Scholarship provides a Hall of Fame members' immediate family with a continuing education scholarship.

- HOF Legend Scholarship will be awarded to any immediate family member that qualifies through the PHAALS Foundation's application process.
- Spouse, son, daughter, grandson and granddaughter are all eligible for this scholarship.
- Applicants will apply to the PHAALS Foundation review board for consideration for approval. The review board will assess and review the applicants and give their professional assessment to the CEO and board of directors for approval
- Applicants will fill out an application and write an essay answering some questions regarding their lives and experiences with Lou Gehrig's Disease and how it has affected their lives.

- Monies will be issued to the university or college of choice.
